

Quick Trading Guide

To commence trading select **File, New, New Futures Trading Window** on the menu tool bar

The window shows the default account number. The drop down will display other accounts. Select the account and give the trade window a name. Then press '**Create**'.



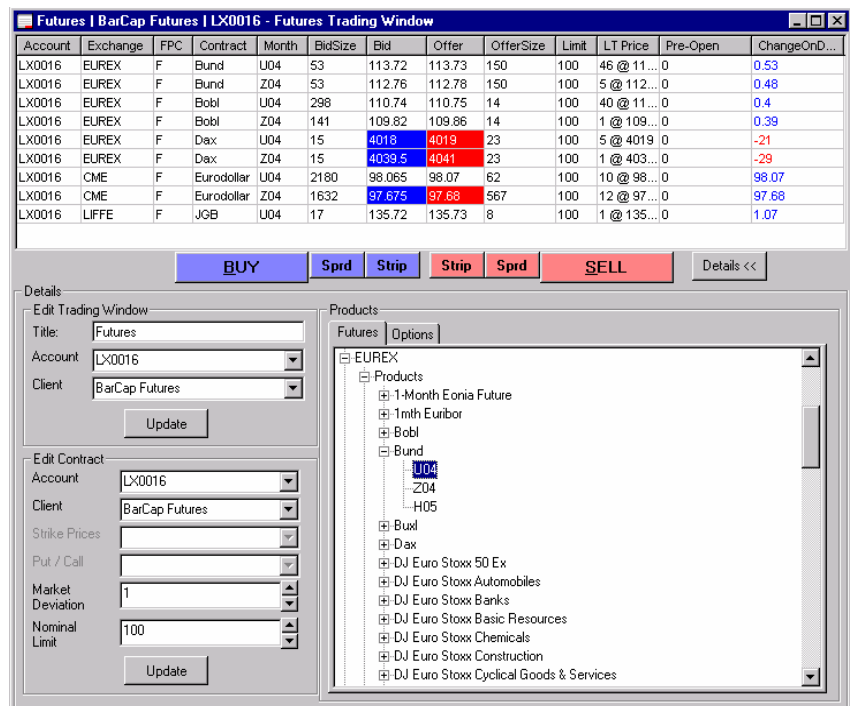
Your Blank trading window will then appear, by Clicking on the **Details>>** option at the bottom of the page an Exchange List will be made available.

Select the exchange by hitting the **+**

Once the exchange has been set. Select either Products or Strategies by clicking **+**

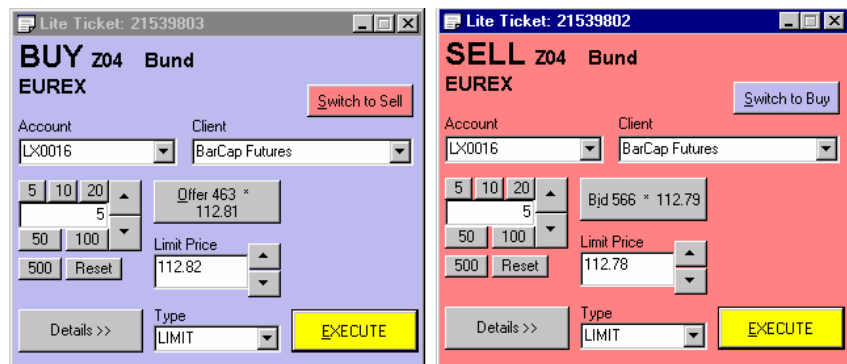
Then select the appropriate Product and then month. Double click the month to add it to the Trading Window.

After selecting your Products/Strategies, press the **Details<<** option and that portion of the screen will disappear.

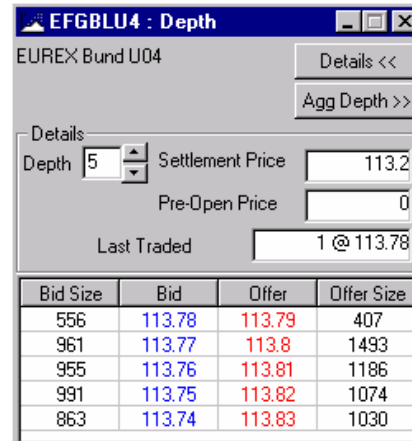
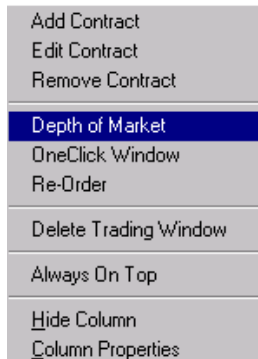


To execute trades, simply click on the **Bid** or **Offer** Price. A Blue window will appear to **BUY** a red to **SELL**.

Populate the volume, change the price if necessary and hit execute. Your blotter will update with the latest trade information.



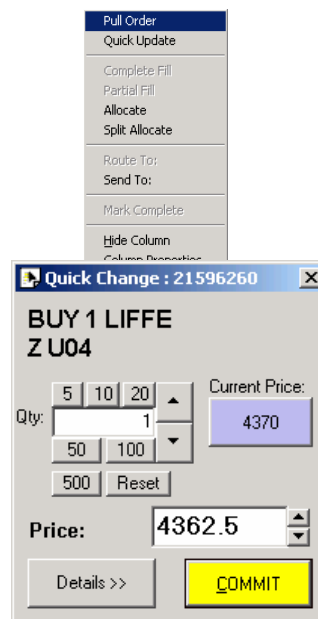
You can also trade via the depth of market window. To do this right click the specific contract in the Trading Window, a menu will appear, select **“Depth of Market”**. As before you can trade by clicking on the **Bid** or **Offer** price.



To Cancel / amend an order, simply highlight the working order in the trade blotter and **Right Click** to reveal the edit menu.

To **Cancel** select **Pull Order** or highlight the order and click on **‘Pull’** on the toolbar on the blotter.

To Change an order select **‘Quick Update’** or highlight order and select **‘Amend’** on the toolbar on the blotter. Change details then **‘Commit’**



Once you have created a trading window or a Depth of Market they will be saved for future trading. On your Toolbar you will have **“Trading Windows”** and **“Depth of Market Windows”** icons, select the dropdown arrow and a list of all your old windows will appear.
